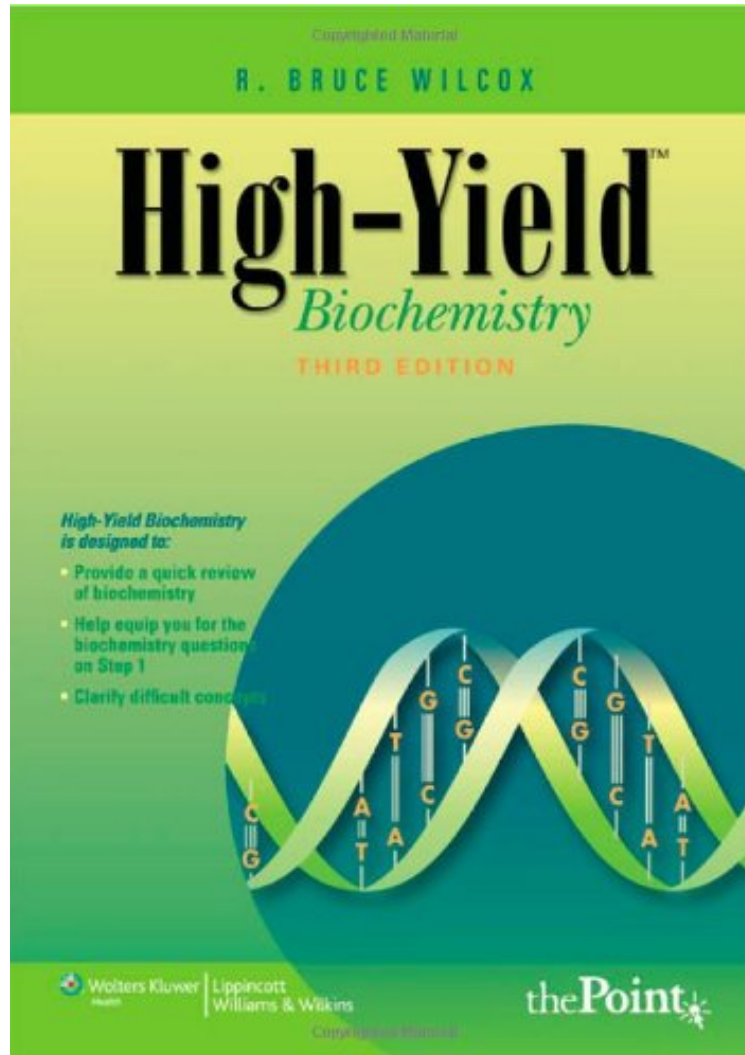

It was intended for those struggling to connect all of the various elements of BioChem. It does not explain BioChem concepts in a remedial way. The subject is easier to understand if you realize that all of the systemic processes are connected as opposed to rotely trying to memorize each module on its own. The author suggests reading it quickly through two times in order for the student to grasp how the various components are related. It's hard to grasp the beauty of a puzzle when the pieces are disconnected.
