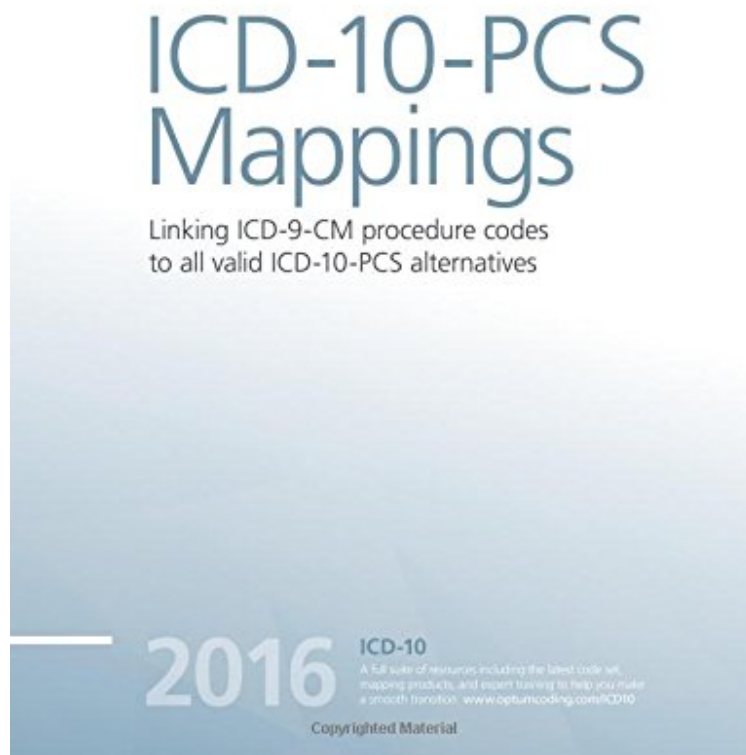



## ICD-10-PCS Mappings 2016
