**Family Practice Coding Tip**

When sufficient clinical information isn't known or isn't available about a particular health condition to assign a more specific code, it is acceptable to report the appropriate "unspecified" code (eg, a diagnosis of pneumonia has been determined, but not the specific type). Unspecified codes should be reported when they are the codes that most accurately reflect what is known about the patient's condition at the time of that particular encounter. The inclusion of the - [dash] symbol indicates that an additional digit is needed.

**Coding Tip**  
Assign 1 (right), 2 (left), 3 (bilateral), or 9 (unspecified).

**Coding Tip**  
Use additional code to identify:  
- exposure to environmental tobacco smoke (Z77.22)  
- history of tobacco use (Z87.891)  
- occupational exposure to environmental tobacco smoke (Z57.31)  
- tobacco dependence (see ICD-10 category F17)  
- tobacco use (Z72.8)
