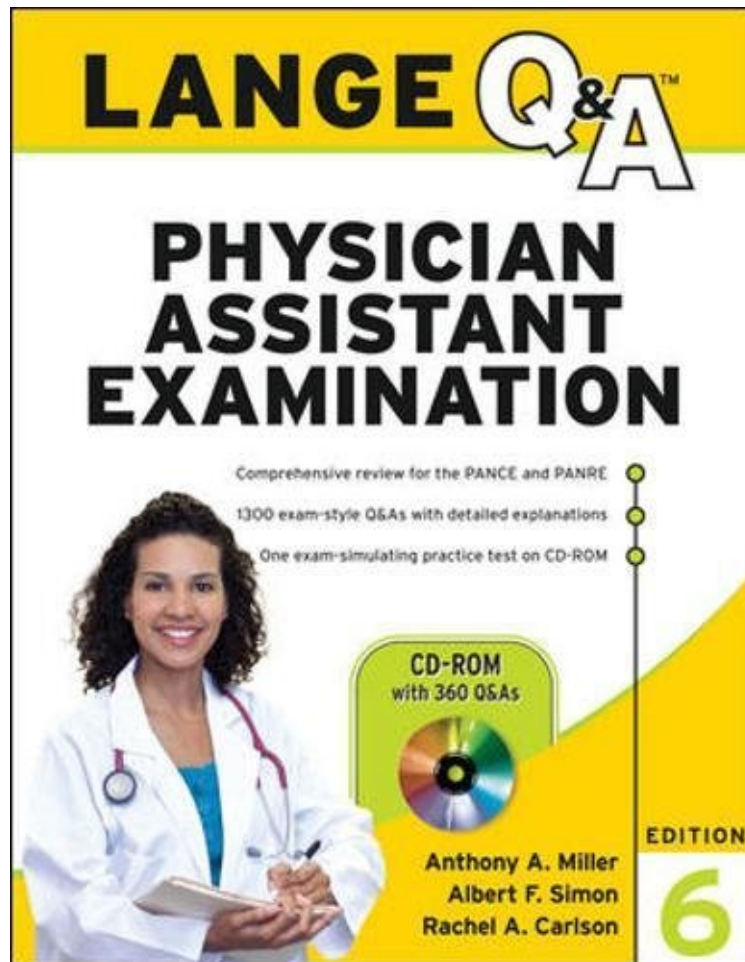

For those of us recertifying, and six or more years from our last exam, the multiple choice test bank provides excellent practice. You can choose the length of your practice test, whether you want to see each question explained as you answer it or wait until the end, and which section of the exam you'd like to take (or retake). There are a total of 360 questions.The study and test-taking skills chapter is also excellent for the first timer or especially the repeat tester. No reason to do poorly

just because you don't know HOW to read the questions!
