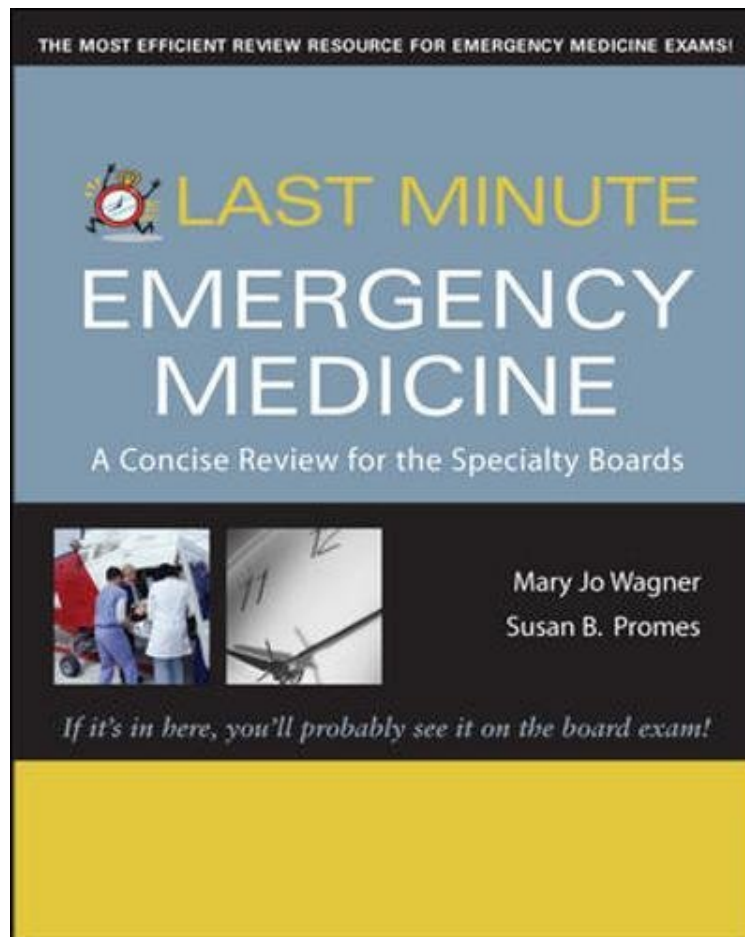

there are numerous typos, which gives the impression that no one edited this book. There are typos in every chapter and many chapters with multiple typos within a given section. Then, there is some information that is flat out wrong (e.g., tumor lysis syndrome causes hypophosphatemia). I have read this book cover to cover and I'm disappointed I did.
