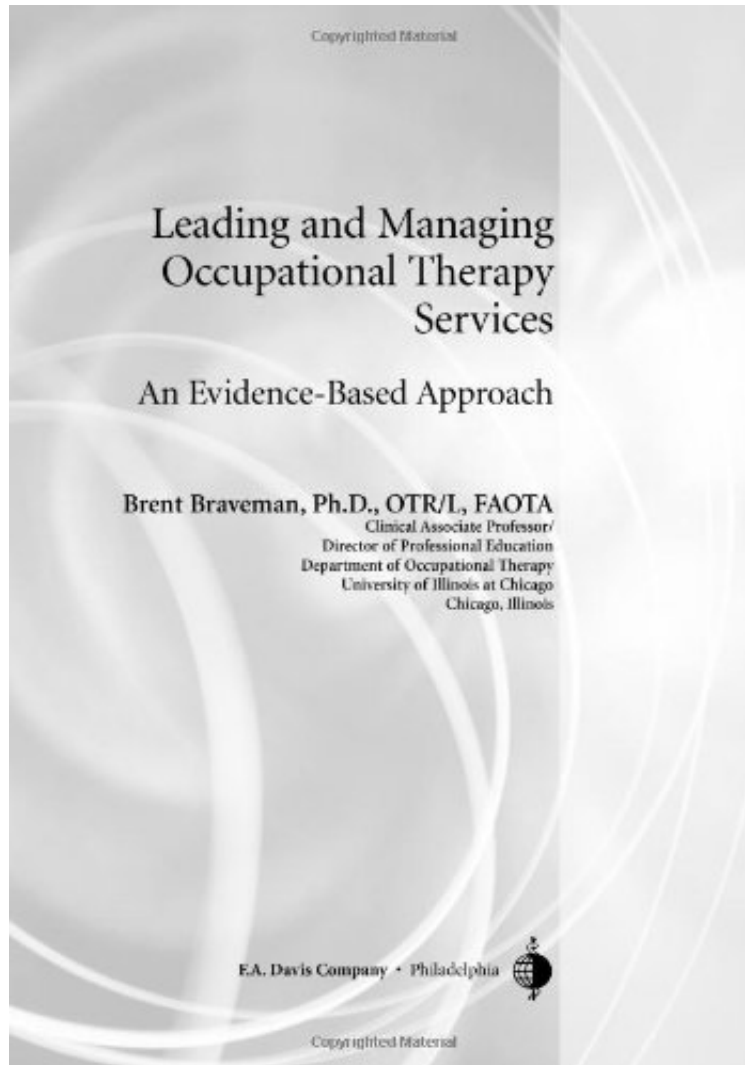


Leading Managing Occupational Therapy Services: An Evidence-Based Approach
