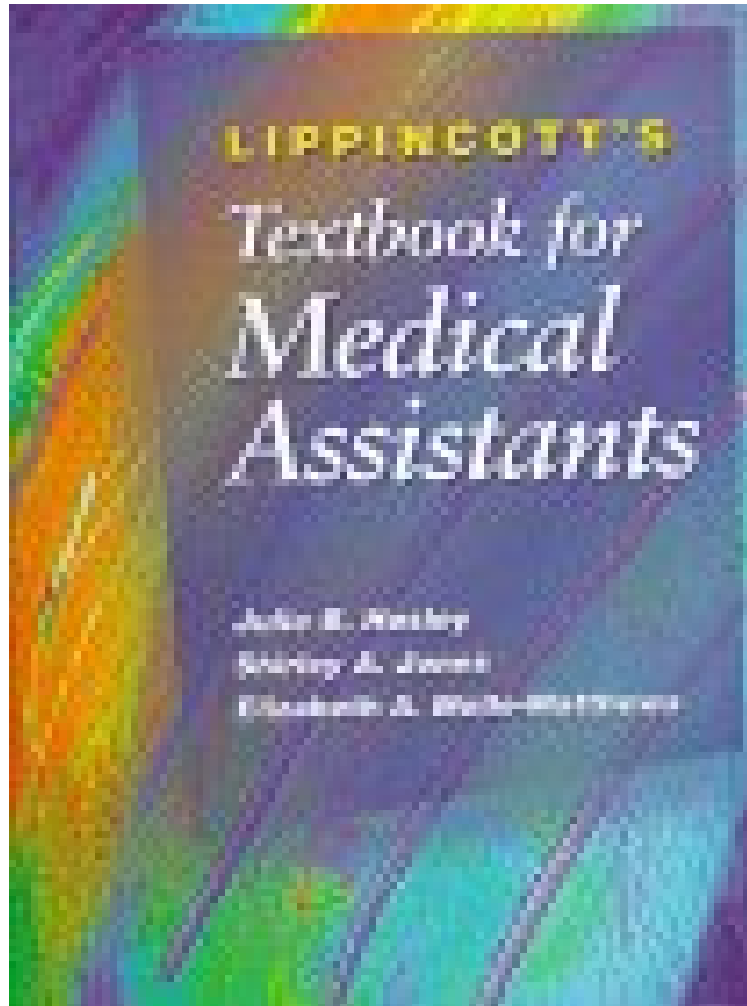

It was Lippincott's first venture into Medical Assisting. What a mistake. Teachers and students complained from day 1 about the erroneous information, outdated data, and the multitude of typos. Additionally, there was little customer service. We were ordering about 2000 copies per year. We switched to another publisher after one year, but never heard from Lippincott!

This text sets the standards for Medical Assistants! Current and comprehensive, this competency-based textbook

provides a wealth of guidance for administrative and clinical skills, emphasizing communication and patient education throughout. All entry-level DACUM competencies are covered, with specific competencies explained separately and listed with DACUM reference numbers. An abundance of step-by-step, four-color illustrated procedures are presented in a two-column format with action and rationale. Each procedure provides an Overview, Equipment, Implementation, and Documentation. The text's unique organization combines a detailed review of anatomy and physiology for each system and lists the clinical medical assistant's role in treating disorders of that system. Coverage includes: charting and documentation; computerization of the medical office; Quality Improvement; new Standard Precautions for infection control; current knowledge on infectious diseases; and working with special populations, including pediatric and geriatric patients. Concluding chapters on Externship and Employment promote a smoother transition to the work environment. Helpful pedagogy, including Key Terms, a Glossary and Critical Thinking Challenges familiarize students with the material and help with problem-solving
