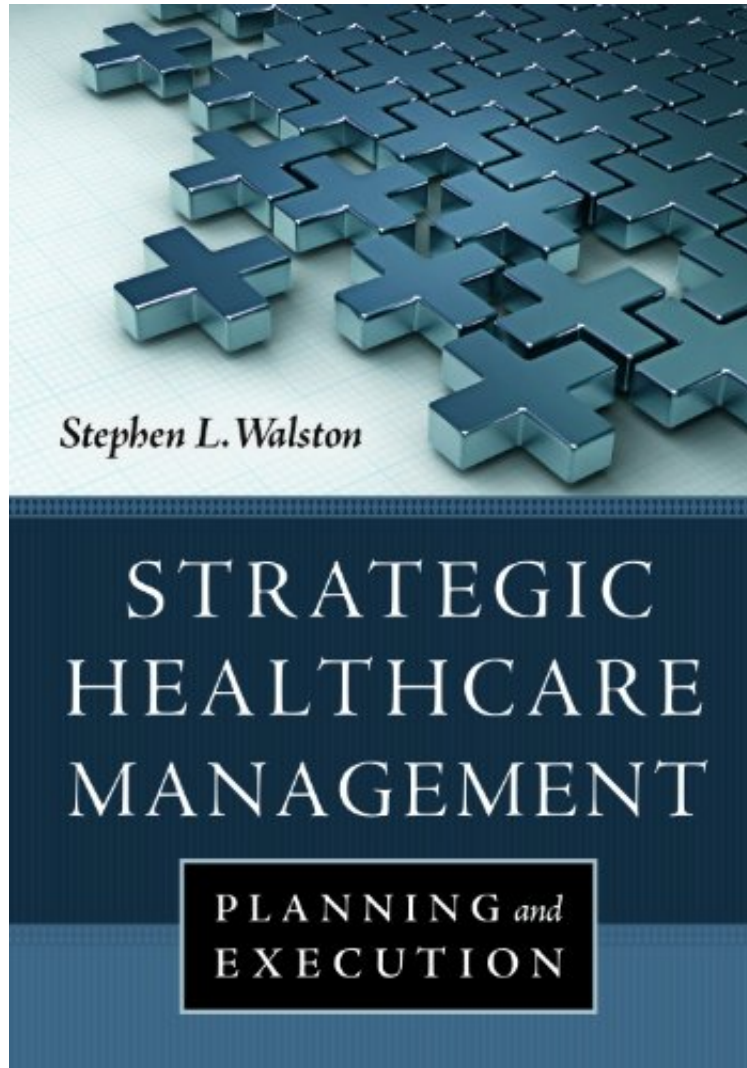


Strategic Healthcare Management: Planning and Execution
