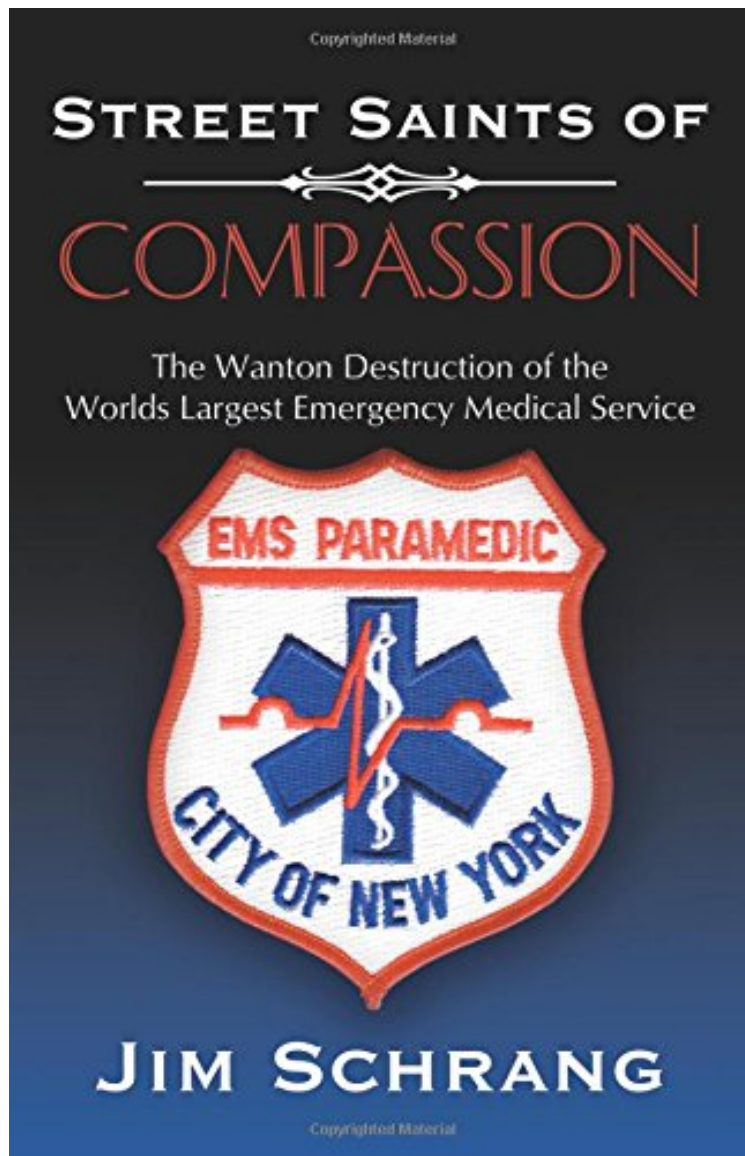

Interviewed on television both in New York and internationally, his photo appeared first on the front page of the New York Times and other international publications in 1993 as he worked to save a wounded child in Sarajevo, Bosnia.
