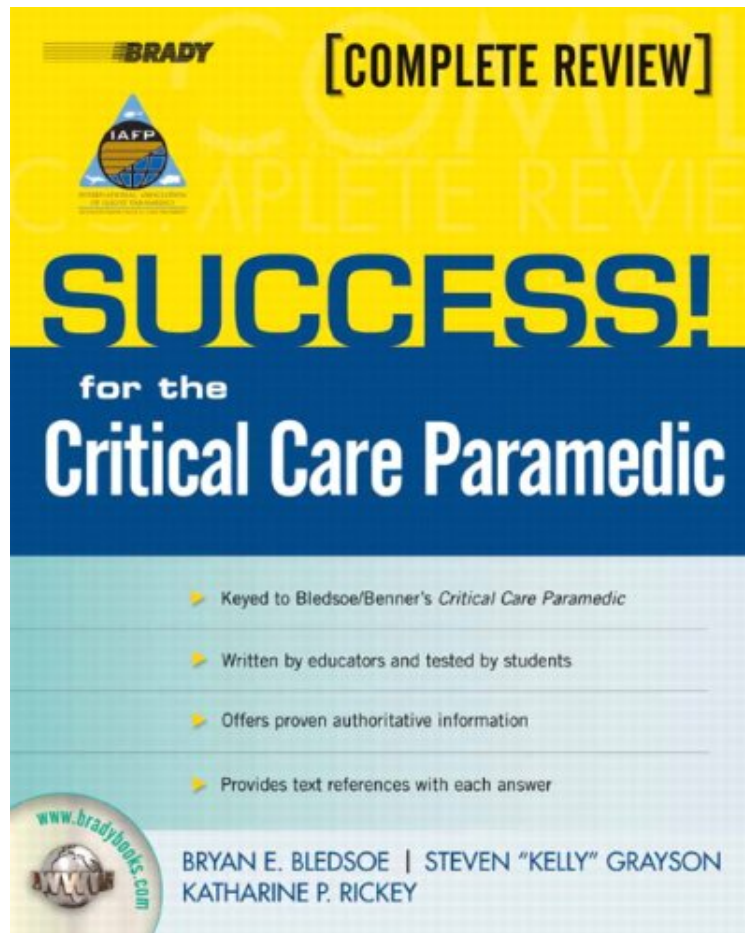

I have to say the questions in this book were much harder than the questions on the actual CCEMTP exam itself. As well, it covered more topics than what was on the actual exam. Unfortunately there were some book questions where I did not agree with the answer or was an obvious mistake on Brady's part. If you are looking for a large amount of multiple choice questions, I recommend this book. Be aware, there is no in book rationale for the answers, just a page reference for the corresponding Brady book. You have to look up the answer yourself. If you don't have the Brady books that accompany this exam book (Critical Care Paramedic and a Brady AP book I can't remember the exact title of), I would not recommend it.
