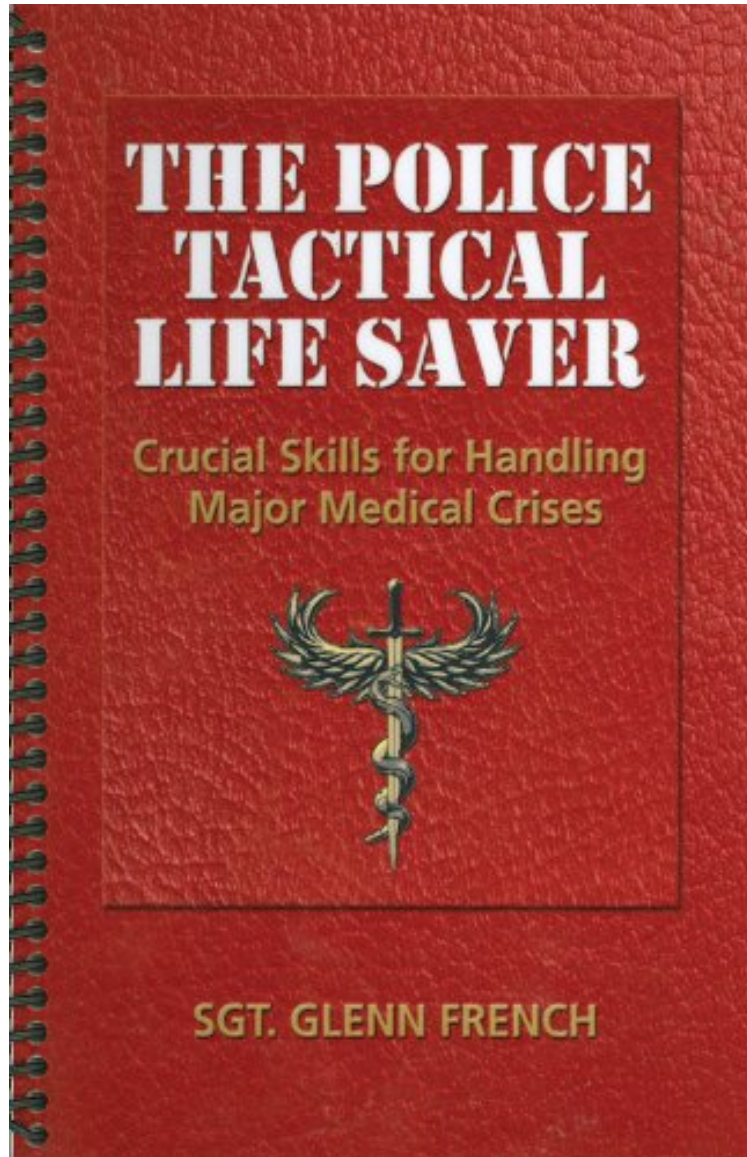

I strongly disagree with tradecraft on many of his points like such as:1) the size of the book,

the compact size, coated pages to protect from the elements were obviously a great idea. My tactical operators keep this book in their packs. The chapters and skill sets are straight forward and to the point. No need trying to fumble through a medical journal as all the pages are to the point for quick reference in combat situations.2) we were able to obtain all the equipment needed from chapter 4 without any issues, found it very helpful.3) chapter 10 on "Airway Management" worked well for us, again easy to read and apply.4) chapter 11 on "Penetrating Chest Trauma Tension Pneumothorax" same as above.5) chapter 13 on "Hemostatic Agents" is just over a page and was all the info we needed for training.I bought this book to expose my officers to Tactical Combat Casualty Care. I like that its condensed for quick reference. My men keep this book in thier "go bags" and my tactical officers keep it in their back packs. The book is spiril bound for quick page turns and durability in the field. The cover and the pages are either water resitant stock or coated for use in the rain and snow.I orginally bought the Combat Medics Field guide but its to big and too much information for cops. That book is 400 pages and 3" thick with information that cops won't use. The Tactical Life Saver is a great fit for size and quick reference for my men.This book is progressive since the author recognzies the need for nasopharyngal airway management tension pneumothorax treatment in a large scale active shooter incident where EMS will not rescue my injured officers! TEMS is great but a couple TEMS guys would have been overwhelmed at Virgina Tech, Columbine Mumbai.I also found through research on the net that officers have been trained in chest decompression 68% retained the skill set 12 months after the initial training. I hope to report me agencies results in 12 months.The NTOA states that all citizens will have these skill sets in the future just like CPR. I agree because these medical skills can be used in natural disasters as well.My experience with this book is very positive, a great quick reference, field guide for patrol officers and tactical officers.
