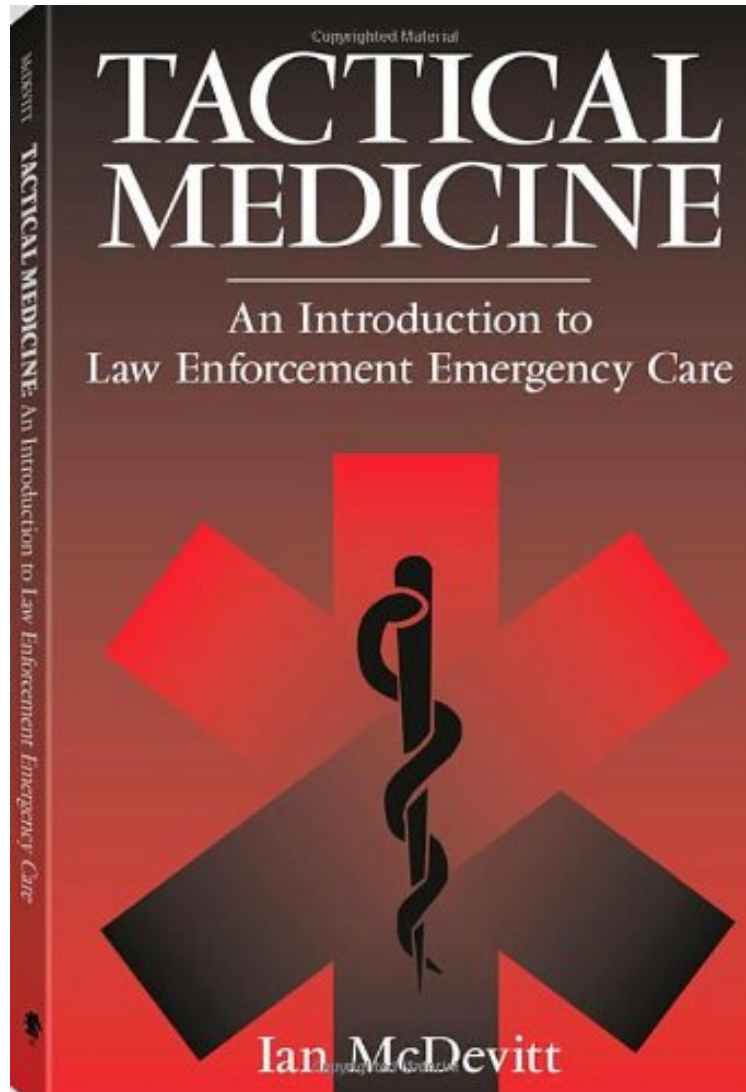

Mr McDevitt had very creative and innovative ideas, especially with improvisation.
