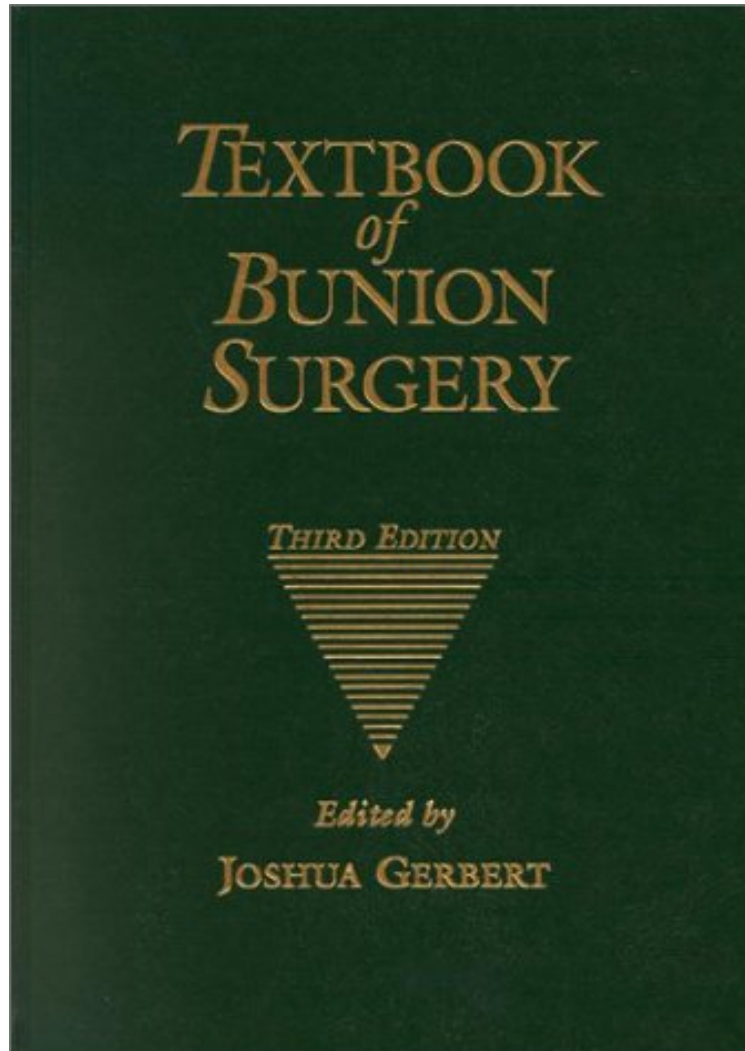

Chapters follow a consistent format with many excellent drawings and

photographs to illustrate the subject. This updated edition has been completely rewritten and revised, with new added topics and findings. Experienced foot surgeons have contributed chapters in their areas of expertise, sharing their knowledge and first-hand clinical experience. A detailed evaluation of the foot and bunion surgery allows you to understand how the various clinical and radiographic findings will help you select the best treatment for a patient. Biomechanical implications related to the bunion deformity give you an understanding of the pathomechanics of the deformity. Preoperative criteria for each procedure allow you to use specific, objective findings in selecting a surgical procedure. Techniques to control the variables related to bunion surgery allow you to utilise various pre-operative, intra-operative, and post-operative techniques to reduce the incidence of a poor surgical outcome.
