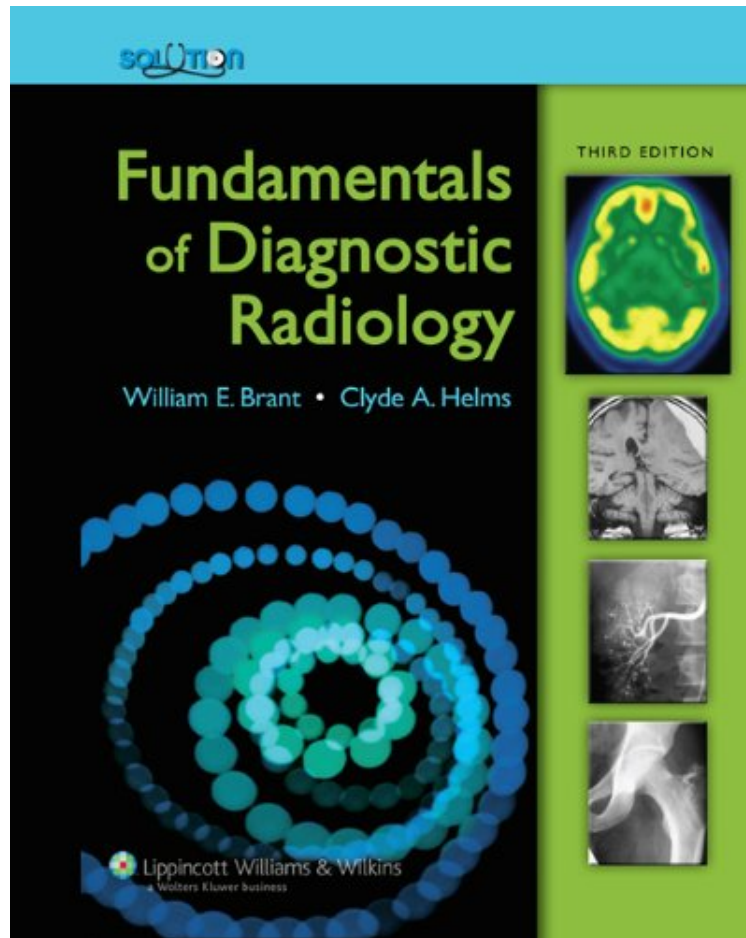

This is the four volume set that I was told is the "Bible" of lower level radiology residents. I was unimpressed. It does cover all organs and all ages but it is very skimpy on pictures, usually giving only a single example of most pathology. Also, if a certain disease is most commonly dx on, say, CT, then no US or MR images are included even if that disease is occasionally dx on those modalities. Worse, many diseases discussed lack any pictures at all. Color images are skimpy. Also it is verbose in some sections that cover extraneous details and lacking in depth on important topics. Equally frustrating is that the index is only in volume IV, making it difficult to access if you only brought volume II to read at work. I read most of it with much effort. Buying and reading more focused books (US Requisites, CXR-Felson, Pediatric Imaging-Donnelly, Body CT-Webb) would be a much better use of your time as an intern or lower level resident.
